# (CONTROL OF PHOTOGRAPHS) REGULATIONS



Commencement: 1st March 1965

### Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the National Registration (Control of Photographs) Regulations. 球法律法

## Photographic requirements.

- Every person taking photographs for the purposes of the National Registration Act, shall comply with the following conditions —
- the paper used for photographs shall be of single weight, semimatt surface, unglazed and of a make approved by the Commissioner;

the minimum thickness of paper shall be 0.076 millimeters and the maximum (b) thickness 0.178 millimeters;

the size of the photograph shall be 35 milimeters by 45millimeters and the photograph shall be without border. The full face and bothears of the person photographed shall appear and the image from the chin to thetop of the head shall be not less than 26 millimeters in a vertical position. The photograph shall be taken against a plain background and balanced lightingshall be used so that no shadows shall be shown;
